

## YOKOHAMA MATHEMATICAL JOURNAL

This journal endeavors to publish significant works in pure and applied mathematics. It had been published by Department of Mathematics, Yokohama City University from the first issue to Volume 40. From Volume 41, it has been published by both Yokohama City University and Yokohama National University. The latter is working mainly from Volume 58 and publishing one volume annually.

*Submission:* To submit a paper, an author should prepare the manuscript in the standard L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X format and send its source file and its PDF output to the Editorial Office by email. The paper must be original and not be submitted for publication elsewhere. The language used must be English.

*Abstract:* Each manuscript is required to contain an abstract, clearly separated from the rest of the paper, which will be printed right after the title. The length of an abstract should not exceed 200 words. Formulas should be used as sparingly as possible in the abstract.

*Footnotes:* Footnotes should not be used, except for title page footnotes. Such information should be included in the text.

*Title Page Footnotes:* Included as a footnote on the first page should be the following:

2010 Mathematics Subject Classification: ······.

Key words and phrases: ······.

Acknowledgement of support, grants and contracts should also be included in this footnote.

*Author's Address:* The permanent address of each author should be typed following the references.

*Proofs and Offprints:* Authors will receive the first proofs for necessary corrections, which should be returned to the Editorial Office within two weeks of receipt. An author receives a PDF copy of his article free of charge, instead of offprints; joint authors should share it.

*Agreement for Online Publication:* Any accepted paper will be accessible later on the web. Authors will be deemed to have agreed to publish it online after their paper was published in print.
